Moeller, Linda A., OCC, Instructor, Physical Education, retirement effective 05/30/05.

Linda Moeller, coach of the OCC's women's crew team since it was created 12 years ago, is retiring after a 25-year career as an associate professor in physical education and athletics. Under her direction, the OCC women's crew has medaled repeatedly at conference championships in Sacramento, and it has been invited to compete in the East Coast Championships six times – a major accomplishment, especially since Orange Coast is the only community college in the nation with a rowing program. The OCC women's crew is a member of the Western Intercollegiate Rowing Association (WIRA) Conference. The crew competes primarily against WIRA and PAC-10 schools. At least once a year the crew faces competition from universities all over the nation. "It's been a very competitive 12 years," Moeller reports. "Women's rowing has become stronger throughout the United States each year." More than 500 women have competed on OCC's crew team led by Moeller, and a high percentage of the athletes continued to row at four-year schools, often with scholarship opportunities. During her years at OCC, Moeller also served as a sailing instructor, sailing team coach and ski team coach. She instructed students in the campus Fitness Lab, and was an instructor/advisor for Associated Students of Orange Coast College for 11 years. Linda earned her undergraduate degree at San Diego State University, and completed her M.A. at California State University, Long Beach. Moeller, who is single, plans to pursue her passion for horses following her retirement. For the past 15 years, she has been riding hunters and jumpers, and is also interested in dressage. Her retirement "dream" is to one day own property where she can enjoy her two horses, Duchess and Durango. Retirement will also

provide an opportunity for Linda to spend more time with her mother, 90, who lives in Newport Beach.
