Board of Trustees

- Trustee Mary Hornbuckle reported she will attend the Westminster Mayor's Ball.
- Trustee Walt Howald commented on the graduation ceremonies at each college and noted that, as a trustee, it is always a joy to take part in the commencement exercises. Trustee Howald said he worked with Erin Curtis and Martha Parham to host legislators on campus tours and will host Chuck DeVore on June 23. Trustee Howald announced he will also be attending the System-wide Strategic Implementation Committee as well as the CCT Board in Sacramento.
- Trustee Armando Ruiz announced he will attend the Westminster Mayor's Ball.
- Student Trustee Jeri Elder said she is excited to have the opportunity to represent all the students of the District and thanked everyone for their support.

Chancellor

- Chancellor Ken Yglesias announced \$500,000 was donated to the District and the colleges by Dr. Richard Houghton. Dr Houghton was a great supporter of the District and provided for the donation through his estate.

Presidents

- Ding-Jo Currie, CCC president, congratulated Jeri Elder on her new roll as Student Trustee and commented that she is very proud that she is from Coastline. President Currie announced that June 15 is the Parent-Student orientation for Early College High School which will begin classes on August 19. Early College High School will allow students to simultaneously earn their high school diploma and an AA degree. Dr. Currie said that in July, CCC will again host the Technology Institute for faculty and staff members.
- Bob Dees, OCC president, distributed a brochure outlining OCC's accomplishments. President Dees announced OCC's summer enrollment is up and it is looking good for the fall. President Dees said the Disney Institute workshop was very successful with over 200 attendees.
