REPORTS

Board of Trustees

- Board President Walt Howald requested that the board members receive copies of the policies pertaining to travel and management hiring. Trustee Howald welcomed Erin Curtis as the new Associate Vice Chancellor, Martha Parham as the new Director of Marketing and Public Relations, and Nancy Sprague as the interim Secretary of the Board. Trustee Howald attended participated in several meetings as a member of the CCCT Board.
- Trustee Mary Hornbuckle reported that she enjoyed the evening at the Westminster Sunken Garden, the Westminster Learning Center and the One Stop Center and thanked Dr. Currie for the tours. Trustee Hornbuckle announced that the League of Women Voters is conducting a study of the community college system.
- Trustee Jerry Patterson expressed that KOCE has performed an invaluable function for the Coast Community College District as a public broadcast station for 30 years. Trustee Patterson expressed his pleasure working with Donna Waldfogel, as secretary of the board congratulated her on her new job as the director of human resources.
- Trustee Armando Ruiz announced that he attended an event at the OCC Sailing Center and thanked OCC for inviting him. Trustee Ruiz also attended the Mayor's Ball in Westminster along with Trustee Patterson and President Currie.

Thomas is looking forward to the leadership challenges and the opportunity to establish a positive relationship with the administrators of the District.
