REPORTS

Board of Trustees

- Trustee George Brown commented that he recently met with Assembly Member Tom Harman to discuss the state budget impasse.
- Student Trustee Derek Shelly reported that he recently attended the California Community College League Student Trustee Conference where he met with student trustees from all over the state.

Presidents

- Ding-Jo Currie, CCC President, reported that there is a feeling of excitement among the faculty and staff at Coastline as they all look forward to the beginning of the semester and the arrival of students. The grand opening event for the college's new bookstore will take place the week of August 26 and is open to everyone.
- Ken Yglesias, GWC President, reported that enrollment for the fall semester is up 8% over last year to approximately 14,000. Phone registration was utilized by 90% of students, drastically reducing the time students spend waiting in line.
- Mel Rogers, KOCE president, announced that the August pledge drive is going well and is on target to meet the projected goals.
- Gene Farrell, OCC interim President, reported that registration is up 6% to 21,630 students. Over 95% of all students registered via telephone at OCC.

Academic Senate Presidents

- Nancy Jones, CCC senate president, reported that the faculty and staff at CCC is excited to start a new semester and looking forward to welcoming new and returning students.

Student Government Organizations

- David Turner, CCC student advisory council (SAC) president-elect, reported that CalSAC is continuing its book drive. Student trustee, Derek Shelly will attend SAC's first meeting to discuss District Student Council.
- Kerri Dawn Jubran, ASGWC president, reported that they have a list of approved items for the Collections for Kindness drive, including school supplies and books. Plans for activities that will honor the victims of September 11 are under way as well as plans for a Welcome Back event.

- Tina Bruning, Coast Federation of Teachers, Local 1911/American Federation of Teachers president, announced that a class would be held at OCC for the new faculty. Contract negotiations continue and the negotiations team is committed to finishing by next week.
