### **Board of Trustees – Workshop Meeting, No Reports**

#### Chancellor

- Ken Yglesias handed out a multiple-choice quiz to find out everyone's knowledge about the Constitution, in honor of Constitution Day. Yglesias then passed his time to Vice Chancellor CM Brahmhatt who gave a report on parity money. Brahmhatt reported that the District has never held on to the part-time faculty's parity money, but the District will not have the money until the state passes a budget. The District would pass on the parity pay to the faculty as soon as they received it from the state. Brahmhatt also gave a report on the budget, saying the District had not been paid for July and August. The District has secured a \$25 million line of credit and has been living off of its reserves. The District is working to ensure that all staff, faculty and vendors are paid on time.
