The Orange Coast College (OCC) Maritime Training Center is requesting proposals from qualified engineering consultants to provide preliminary engineering and Caltrans project development liaison services in support of a proposed pedestrian bridge overcrossing of State Route 1 – West Coast Highway in the City of Newport Beach. Scope will additionally include site related civil engineering work, including (but not limited to) preliminary engineering of a retaining wall into the site slope, structurally and aesthetically.
