Student Admissions Applications

Issue

Should the Coast Community College District have three separate admissions applications (current practice) or should CCCD implement a District admissions application?

Impacts

- Registration priority
- Matriculation status
- Registration appointment distribution.

Resolution

Keep the current policy of one admissions application per college in keeping with each campus' identity.

If practicable, further facilitate some students desire to cross enroll. Design and develop a way in Banner to allow students to complete a short/abridged online application which indicates an intent to enroll at another college in the District. In other words, if a student has a current admissions application on file at one of the colleges in the District, allow the student to complete a short application, which would trigger the priority registration/appointment and matriculation rules for that college.
