Coastline Community College received a grant from the U.S. Department of Defense/National Security Agency (NSA) titled "**Cybersecurity Instructional Success Network (CISN)**." Coastline Community College would establish a National Center of Academic Excellence in Cyber Defense - Two-Year Education (CAE2Y) Regional Resource Center to provide assistance to the 113 California community colleges and other western regional colleges in preparation for their application to CAE2Y designation. Assistance would consist of application-specific training opportunities, application peer review opportunities, and hosting of faculty professional development workshops and webinars. Additionally, Coastline would serve as a CAE2Y community resource center to CAE2Y colleges and those interested in applying for the designation.

Fiscal Impact: Coastline Community College would receive \$163,696 from October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017. No matching funds required.

21.00 Approval of Non-Standard Agreements in Excess of \$87,800

21.01 DIS – Non-Standard Agreement with PFM Financial Advisors, LLC

On a motion by Trustee Hornbuckle, seconded by Trustee Moreno, the Board voted to approve the non-standard agreement with PFM Financial Advisors, Under Request For Qualifications (RFQ) 2003, the District seated the bond finance and legal advisory team to serve the needs of Measure M. Among the team members was Public Financial Management, Inc. (PFM) who was

identified as the Financial Advisor. The team currently consisted of RBC as lead underwriter, Citi and Piper Jaffray as co-underwriters, Stradling, Yocca, Carlson & Rauth as bond counsel, and PFM as pricing consultant. Up to this point the scope of PFM had been drawn very narrowly and their role had been largely defined as that of Pricing Consultant. In this capacity, as the District had sought to issue bonds, they had engaged with the group to provide guidance and an opinion concerning the acceptability of the terms and conditions identified by the team of Underwriters. More recently, and to be consistent with the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) best practices, along with evolving industry-accepted roles and responsibilities within debt transactions, staff believed that broadening the narrowly defined scope of our Financial Advisor to that of independent municipal advisor, who serves in a fiduciary relationship to the issuer, serves the interests of the District. In this capacity, PFM would be available to prepare any necessary analysis relative to bond issuance.

Term: October 1, 2016 through December 31, 2023.

Fiscal Impact: \$55,000 per issuance to be paid with bond proceeds at the close of a transaction.
